Introduction and Context

This project analyzes the Wat's The Story dataset, a collection of news articles on cybersecurity, technology, marketing, stock markets, and Irish news, spanning from October 2023 to 2024. The goal was to uncover meaningful trends, sentiment patterns, and thematic overlaps, aligning with Wat's The Story's mission of delivering clear and impactful news.

Analysis Techniques

The dataset was transformed and analyzed using:

- Data Cleaning: Handled missing values, standardized text, and added features like word count and cleaned summaries.
- Keyword Extraction: Used Scikit-learn's CountVectorizer to identify dominant themes.
- Sentiment Analysis: Applied TextBlob to classify sentiments into positive, negative, and neutral categories.
- Visualizations: Created charts, word clouds, and trends using libraries like Matplotlib and Plotly.



Tech-News comes second with 2,512 articles, showing significant interest in technology updates and innovations.


Niche Focus:

Trend: The number of articles has significantly increased from October 2023 (50 articles) to peak months like August 2024 (2145 articles), showing steady growth in content production.


Key Period: The months from August to October 2024 were highly productive, with over 2000 articles each month




Total Word Count/percentage by Topic














Interlinked Dynamics of Cybersecurity, Technology, and Market Behavior:

Trend Analysis: Fluctuations in Startup Mentions Over Time:




A noticeable decline in startup mentions in early 2024, followed by a steady rise from March 2024.


